

Facts About Your Taxes

Payments may be mailed to the City Treasurer, P.O. Box 690, Whitewater WI 53190 (Phone No. 262-473-1382) or paid in person in the Whitewater Municipal Building, Finance/Utility counter, 312 W Whitewater Street, OR left in the drop box located between the entry doors. You may pay 1/2 or ALL of the real estate taxes by January 31, 2018. The remaining (second) 1/2 must be paid to the **COUNTY TREASURER** by July 31, 2018. Bills under \$100 cannot be split. Special Assessments must be paid in full by January 31, 2018 even if using the installment method of payment.

Personal Property taxes must be paid in full by January 31, 2018.

Checks should be made payable to THE CITY OF WHITEWATER.

Dog licenses are also due at this time! Please bring rabies vaccination certificate. Male or Female-\$30.00, Neutered or Spayed-\$15.00. Dog Licenses must be paid with a SEPARATE check.

CREDIT CARD & DEBIT CARD payments will be accepted ON-LINE ONLY and will be assessed a convenience fee. ON-LINE E-check payments are free.

Office hours are Monday-Friday, 8 am to 5 pm. The City Finance Office will be closed on Monday & Tuesday, December 25-26, 2017 and Monday, January 1, 2018.

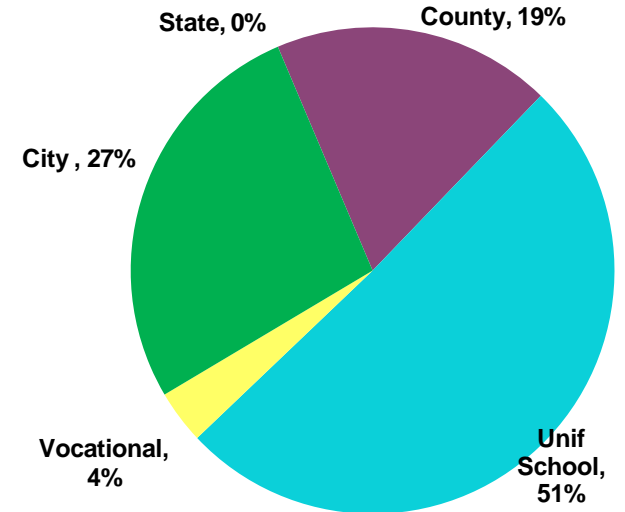

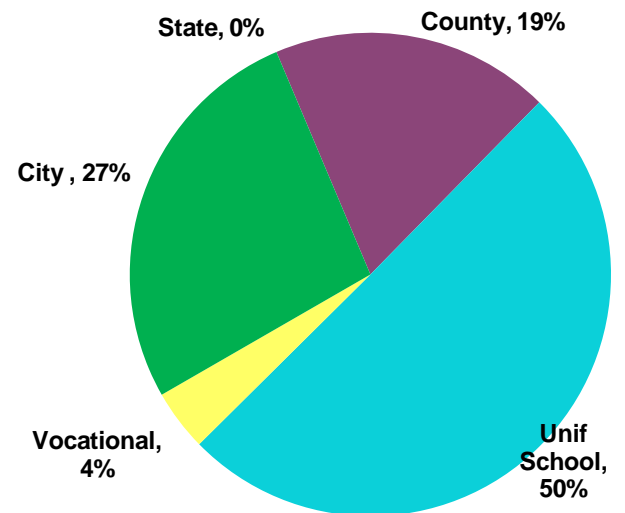

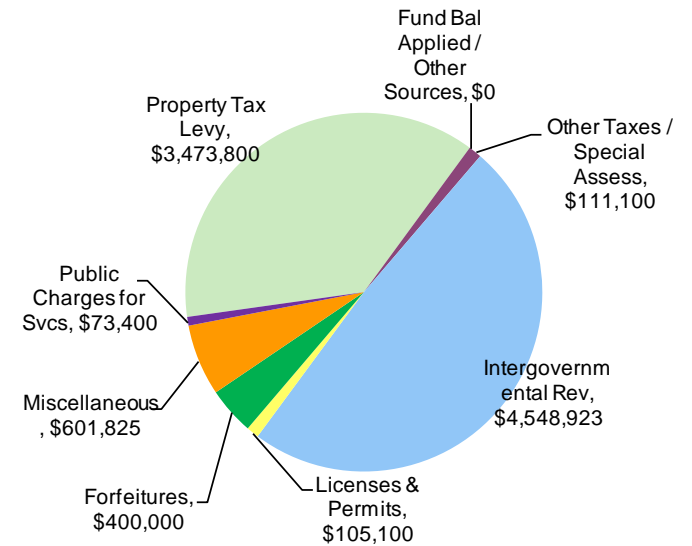
