### DAY 1 – Bourbons Bistro and "Bourbon 101" Class

**DAY 3 – Kentucky Horse Park, Woodford Reserve and Buffalo Trace**

In Bardstown stop at the Heaven Hill Bourbon Heritage Center. Your guide will walk you through the history and heritage of America's original whiskey. Later, sample some of the nation's most critically acclaimed bourbons. Tonight, take to the river for a narrated cruise followed by a delicious dinner. **(Breakfast and dinner)**
