



HELPFUL INFORMATION ABOUT LAWS AND RULES

1. No one can intentionally cause bodily harm to another person or child, which includes any form of injury, including bruising, scratching, etc. – Wis. State Statute 940.19 and Wis. State Statute 948.03 (child)
2. Persons age of 16 years or younger cannot consent to sexual contact of any kind. – Wis. State Statute 948.02
3. Domestic abuse incidents are illegal, these incidents can involve any co-habitants. – Wis. State Statute 968.075
4. School attendance is mandatory for those children under age of 18. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.61.010
5. Do not drive without a valid driver's license. – Wis. State Statute 343.05
6. Vehicles need to be registered in the state in which they are stored, i.e., vehicles in Wis. need Wis. registration. – Wis. State Statute 341.04
7. Motor vehicle liability insurance is needed on every vehicle that is operated. – Wis. State Statute 344.62
8. Do not drive while under the influence of alcohol or other impairing drugs. – Wis. State Statute 346.63
9. Those under the age of 18 must comply with the curfew ordinance. No one under the age of 18 should be on the street without the supervision of a parent or legal guardian from Sunday to Thursday 11pm-4am or Saturday and Sunday from 12AM-4AM. If any minor is found in the street without supervision, the minor and the guardian can be fined. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.62.010
10. It is illegal to provide alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. – Wis. State Statute 125.07
11. Do not consume alcohol in unauthorized public places. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.36.020(15)
12. No person in such a state of intoxication as to disturb others or unable to care for one's self, shall be in any public place. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.36.010
13. Residential noise disturbances can be considered violations at any time of the day. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 19.58.040
14. No person shall fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order, signal or direction of an officer. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.03.010
15. No person shall litter on private or public property. Fine amount for littering is \$124.00 – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.23.010
16. It is against the law to lie to a police officer. – City of Whitewater Ordinance 7.02.010 and Wis. State Statute 946.41
